It is a great way to learn more about the school and feel more connected to other parents and school administrators. We plan events for the Hollys families and fundraise for the schools. Funds are distributed to standing grants and a special item(s) identified each school year. Last year the PTCO decided our special fundraising would be for technology. We will work with the school administration to determine what technology would be most useful for the schools this year. A comment was made that the PTCO should be more vocal about what the PTCO has been able to contribute to the Hollys as many of the attendees were not aware of where the funds have gone in recent years.</p> <p>The group discussed that there are plenty of opportunities for new PTCO members to provide helping hands and contribute to our efforts without taking on an official position.</p>
<p>Principal Update:</p> <p>Things are going fabulous this year. The Hollys teachers are amazing! Molly loves the Hollys, with the exception of the logistical challenges of having two buildings. Molly and Angie are jointly sharing responsibilities for both schools and kids/issues. They are splitting their time at each school so a leader is in each school everyday. They are making a concerted effort to be in the classrooms/lunchrooms/hallways so they are visible to the students. Historically, teachers attending a portion of PTCO meetings. Moving forward, these updates will be provided to the larger school community in a different setting.</p> <p>A concern was raised about alcohol bottles at high school bus stop.
